

**THE LORD WILL
PRESERVE YOU
FROM ALL EVIL. Psalm 121 : 7**

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ who await the promise of the Lord this month.

The promise of the Lord this month that comes to you is

“The Lord will preserve you from all evil”

Psalm 121: 7.

Yes! Our Lord is going to preserve you from all evil. Our God is a marvelous God and He is always willing to protect you from all evil. We read in **Mathew 6:13**, ***“ And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.”*** As we pray the Lord’s Prayer everyday we will have the divine protection from all evil.

Our God has given us several verses in the Bible to encourage us not to fear evil. Many times we fear witchcraft, black magic and other similar things that the devil uses. But

in **Isaiah 54:17** we read, ***“No weapon formed against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from me,” says the Lord.***” Therefore let us not fear but be ready to face the schemes of the devil.

Moreover, our Lord gives us the authority to overcome evil. The authority that the Lord has given us is very powerful as we read in **Luke 10:19**, ***“ I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions, and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.”*** But many times we do not really realize the authority God has given us to trample the serpents and scorpions in our lives.

God has given us the key to bind the devil in this world. But many times we keep the key and look for other ways to bind the devil. We read in **Mathew 16:19**, *“I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosened in heaven.”* Our God loves us and He wants you to bind the devil in this world. Fear not!

God’s top priority is to keep us from temptation and evil forces. But many times we complain that God is tempting us and we lose all hope. But we need to understand that God is with us and He is willing to protect us from all evil. As we read in **James 1:13** *“when tempted, no should say, “God is tempting me.” For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone”* Therefore our God will surely deliver you from all evil and will not tempt you.

Our God, sent His only begotten son (Jesus) and have broken the strong holds of the devil in our lives as we read in Heb 2:14, *“Since the Children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death, that is the devil.”* Therefore be bold and take courage in the liberating power of our God.

There are certain things that we need to do in order to shun the devil in our Lives.

- 1. Pray to be protected from the devil**
- 2. Submit to God**
- 3. Keep us clean from sin**
- 4. Empower ourselves with God’s word and take His authority.**
- 5. Stand firm and resist the devil.**
- 6. Have the surety that God is with us.**

First, we need to pray in order to be protected from the devil and pray for others to be protected from evil as we read in **John 17:15-16**, “ *My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. They are not of the world, even as I am not of it.*” The more we pray the more we will be separated from the world and will be protected from the evil one.

Second, we need to submit ourselves to our God and be in His will for us. We must learn to walk closer to God every day as we read in **James 4:7,8**, “*Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Come near to God and he will come near to you.*” The more you move closer to God the more the devil will flee from you.

Third, we as children of God must keep ourselves clean from sin in our lives as we read in, **1 John 5:18** “*We know that anyone born of God does not continue to sin; the one who was born of*

God keeps him safe, and the evil one cannot harm him” Only when we maintain such purity the devil will flee from us.

Fourth, we need to empower us with the authority that our God has given us, as we read in **Psalm 91:13**, “*You will tread upon the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent*” The more we have the confidence in the authority that the Lord has given us the more we can chase the devil in our lives.

Fifth, we need to stand firm and resist the devil. Our war is not against flesh and blood but against the powers of darkness as we read in **Ephesians 6:10-13**, “ *Finally, be strong in the Lord, and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take stand against the devil’s schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against authorities, against the power of*

this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground.” A good understanding about over-coming the devil will get us success. Therefore we need to understand the tools of the devil and fight against the devil and his evil powers.

Finally, we need to have the surety that God is with us and He will not allow us to be tempted beyond what we can handle as we read in **I Cor 10:13**, *“No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.”* Therefore, stand firm and fight the battle with all your strength. The victory is always ours. Praise God!

Dates of ministry: 14.03.2011 – 18.03.2011

The expenses for the first day and last day meeting place, sweets, food, and parcels were taken care by : *Pastor Y. Jeevadurai, A.G.Church, Poondi.*

Testimonies of the village ministers

Group 1: Sisters: *Louis, Abiyel Anthoniammal, Deborah, Margaret.*

We shared the Gospel and gave Gospel book to every home in *Segampalayam* village. During that time, a sister named Rani came to us and told us to pray for her 6 year old daughter who was not able to speak and was physically handicapped. We prayed for her with burden. The girl looked at us and stretched out her hands and received the John's Gospel book from us. Glory to God! When we shared the good news with a woman named Vasuki in *Kungumapalayam* village, she accepted the Gospel and told us that she would to the Church every Sunday. Totally 1000 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 2: Brothers: *Israel, Noah, Selvarayar Paul, Maharajan.*

We did ministry in 10 villages. Everyone received the Gospel books. We went to villages where 90% of them did not know about Jesus. Some Christians listened to the Gospel. We did not have any opposition. Totally 1200 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 3: Sisters: *Mariammal, Grace Padma, Jothimani, Devabackiyam.*

People welcomed us in the

villages we went. When we gave John's Gospel to every house, received it with happiness. We prayed for many. Totally 980 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 4: Brothers: *Prem Anand, Asir Pandi, Abraham, Susai Manickam.*

We gave Gospel book to a young girl and shared the gospel in *Kulathupalayam* village. Her mother came to us running and asked us if we would receive such books from them. She also argued loudly that we criticized their gods and told us to go away. In *Periyaiepalayam* village, a man asked us if we had come to do religious propagation and was about to chase us. We finished the ministry and left to another village. Totally 1400 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 5: Brothers: *Joshua, Stephen raj, Selvaraj, Jebaraj.*

When we were ministering in *Samundipuram* village, a young man asked us why we came there. We answered him that we had come to tell about Jesus. He threatened us that he would send people to beat us. Then he also threatened the pastor of that area. Then police

was called and they came. They sorted out the problem and asked us to go away. Then we went and ministered in other places peacefully. Totally 1000 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 6: Sisters: *Esther, Pitchaiammal, Salomi Samanasu, Kiruba Palaniammal, Esther Ebenezer.*

A person called us towards him in *Santhapalayam* village. When we went he asked us if we had no other way to earn money. He asked us to stay there so that he would bring 10 people. We moved away from that place. Totally 1000 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 7: Sisters: *Esther Kanagabujam, Anthony Mary, Amirtham, Sheela, Kasthuri Subbiah.*

We shared the Gospel in *Puthupalayam* village without any hindrances. After ministering in *Saamanthikottai* village we went to *Vengamedu*. On the way a person who came in bike stopped us and enquired where we came from and who sent us. He said that they did not want Jesus and threatened us to go away. He also said that our hands and legs would be

broken and all the books would be torn if we don't leave the place. He also said that we came simply there by getting money from foreign sources and chased us by telling that their god would save them. Totally 1000 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 8: Sisters: *Ruth, Rebecca, Maniammal, Annal, Devakirubai.*

In *Saalaipalayam*, some people surrounded us and locked us in a house. There we were abused with bad words. After sometime, they took us to the police station. We were inquired for about an hour and then they got signatures from us and asked us to leave that place. Then we were sent to Thiruppur by bus with police security. We came back to Avinashi in the night and the next day we did ministry in a nearby village named *Muthuchetyapalayam*. We prayed for many people there. That time, some young men came to us and asked us why we came. They grabbed the gospel books from us and threatened us. Again a police man came, warned us and sent us back. Totally 1110 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 9: Sisters: *Vasantha, Clements Mary, Lourdu Mary, Chellakani.*

When we gave John's Gospel books in Lakshminagar area, some accepted them and some refused to get them. One person told us that we should not distribute books. He brought some more people and scolded us with bad words. Then they grabbed the Gospel books from us and put them on the floor. They took photo of us in their cell phone. They took us to the police station. We were warned and they sent us back. The people who took us to the station, returned all the gospel books. Some of the political people in the group received the Gospel books from us. Totally 250 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Group 10: Brothers: *Manasseh, Anthony, Jebamalinathan, Peter Ramalingam.*

We distributed Gospel books in the surrounding villages of *Kuppandapalayam*. We prayed for a person who could not speak or walk for 8 years due to witchcraft. When we prayed he got healed and was able to walk and talk. In *Kunnangal* village, we met

with 5 ladies in a house. We gave John's Gospel book to them. One lady from that group did not accept the book. After we left the place, that lady came running behind us and asked us if we would pray for her dog. We went with her and saw the dog in the dying stage. The dog got healed when we prayed for it. Seeing this, the lady received the Gospel book from us and asked us to pray for her. Totally 900 Gospel books and 1000 Cross-flags were distributed.

Leadership Characters of Moses

As we look at the life of Moses we can see several leadership characters that made him a powerful leader. Let us look into some of these characters.

Moses identified himself with the people

Moses identified himself with the Israelites. He really didn't have to identify, but he identified which first of all marks his leadership Character. It would really cost him to go back to the Israelites, and no one would have known the difference if he had been in the palace itself, but he chose to intercede for the Israelites. He could have continued to lead a comfortable life. But he didn't. He was a leader who involved with the people.

In today's world, it is very difficult to see such leaders like Moses.

He was a man of humility

Though he had all the power of Pharaoh's palace, he identified himself with the Israelites. This required tremendous humility. When a person has power it can lead him to arrogance. But Moses overcomes his ego when he walked out of the palace. Only when someone is truly humble can be an effective long-term leader.

In today's context many people forget their roots from which they came from. When people get wealth, riches and honor they tend to forget how they came up in life. They try to erase their past. But Moses was different and portrayed humbleness as we read in Number 12:3 "Moses was the meekest man on the earth, far above all others living on the face of the earth".

He was a man of empathy

Moses empathized with Israelites. Their pain was his pain. This kind of Leadership is very hard to find in today's context. Many times we never care to bother about others. But when it comes to us we are very worried and we want to do something to rectify it.

A true leader will empathize for his fellowmen. Therefore, empathy is a key to strong leadership as Moses had it as his prime leadership character.

He was a man of responsibility

When Moses found that the Israelites lacked a leader, he recognizes a need for healthy leadership and he comes forward. Therefore Moses was a leader who saw the need at hand and he recognized that the task was crucial and found no one else is doing it so he takes it up.

Moses wasn't perfect, he wasn't experienced, he stuttered when he spoke. But when he saw his people were in trouble, he acted. He took responsibility, even at risk to his own life. Therefore our God almighty chose him to lead. What are we willing to risk?

He was a man of Inquisitiveness

Moses was inquisitive in the way he said "let me now turn aside and see this great sight. Why the thorn-bush is not burnt." Exodus 3:3. Also Moses asked God that he would like to see the Glory of God. Therefore, Moses had this quality of inquisitiveness as his strength to lead the Israelites.

If a leader in today's context has this kind of inquisitiveness God will show him/her new things and take him/her to new heights.

He was a man who feared God.

Moses feared God. We can see this in Exodus 3:6, "At this, Moses hid his face, because he was afraid to look at God". The more we fear God the lesser we will have the fear of men. A good leader must fear God alone and be should be bold to takes steps God requires him/her to take.

He was an Intercessor

Moses was an intercessor. He pleads to God on behalf of the Israelites. We see this quality of Moses as we read in Numbers 14: 11-21. Moreover, Moses sought God's glory, and did not depend on his own strength. Only when a leader is able to intercede for his people, he/she can be an effective leader.

He was a man who put his faith in God

Moses put his faith in God. By faith, Moses leaves Egypt not fearing the king's anger as we read in Heb 11:27, "By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible". Moreover, by faith he delivers the people of Israel from the hands of Pharaoh. A leader with faith in God can move mountains.

But in today's context many leaders put their faith in their education, money, or power, which will not take them far. Therefore, leaders need to have faith as Moses had.

He was a selfless man

Moses was a selfless man. We see this quality of Moses many times in the Bible. He cares for the people of Israel and he did not seek personal glory for him. He dedicated himself for the people of Israel. Unless, a seed dies it cannot produce many fruits. Therefore, a leader in today's world needs to commit themselves for the people in order to expand the kingdom of God.

He was a man who listened to God.

Moses listened to God. He did what God expected him to do. Today, for a Christian Leader, the skill of listening is a very important. Only when we listen to God's voice, we can get fruitful ideas in our ministry.

Reading the life of Moses, we can learn a lot of leadership aspects. Leadership for Moses was very unique to him, because of his background and his up-bringing. Similarly, God has a very unique plan for our lives. *Glory to God! Bro. Stephen Christopher*
